
Deculturalization and the Struggle for Equality: A Brief History of the Education of Dominated Cultures in the United States, 6th Edition

Spring emphasizes issues of power and control in schools and shows how the dominant Anglo class has stripped away the culture of minority peoples in the U.S. and replaced it with the dominant culture. In the process, he gives voice to often-overlooked perspectives of African Americans, Asian Americans, Hispanic/Latino Americans, and Native Americans. An understanding of these historical perspectives and how they impact current conditions and policies is critical to teachers success or failure in todays diverse classrooms.
