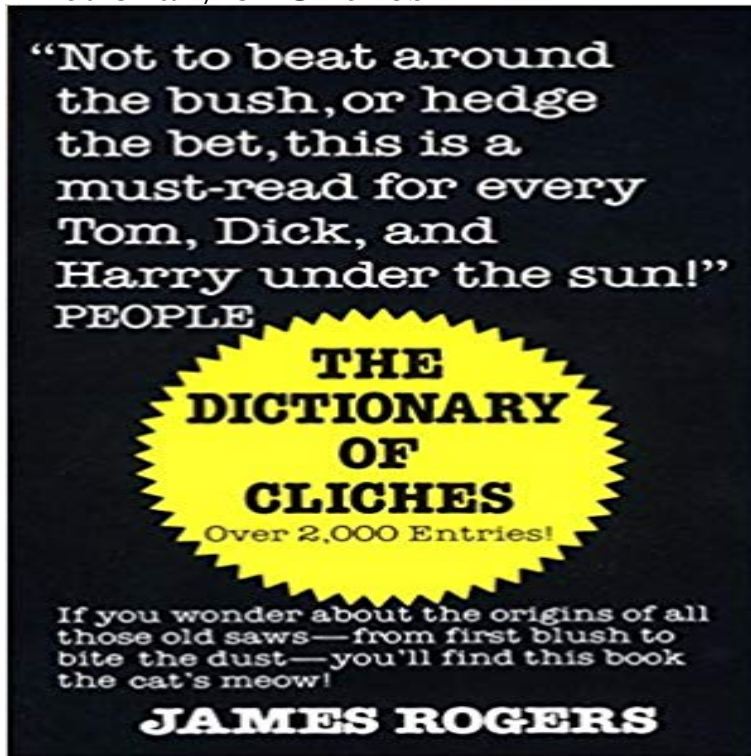


Dictionary of Cliches
