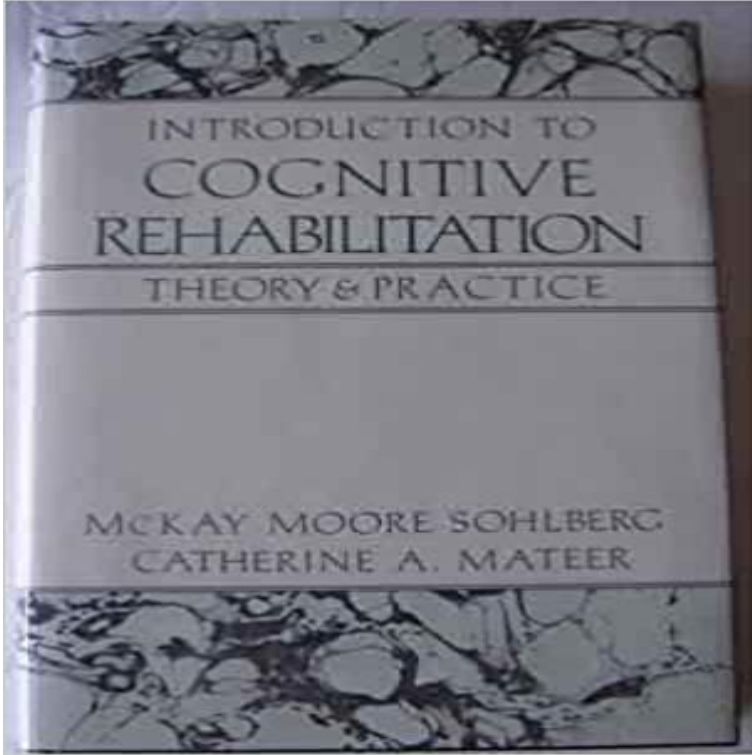


Introduction to Cognitive Rehabilitation: Theory and Practice
