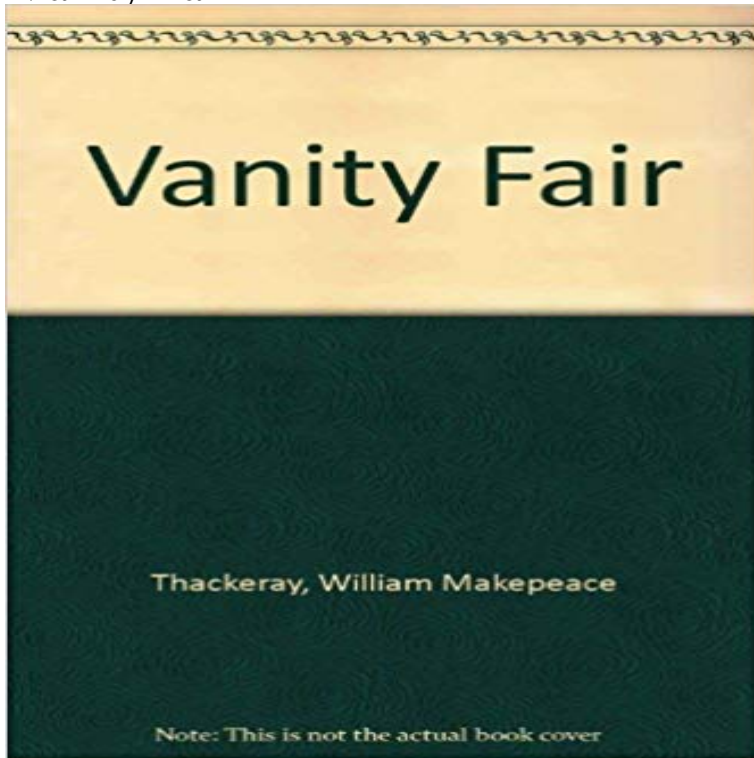


Vanity Fair
