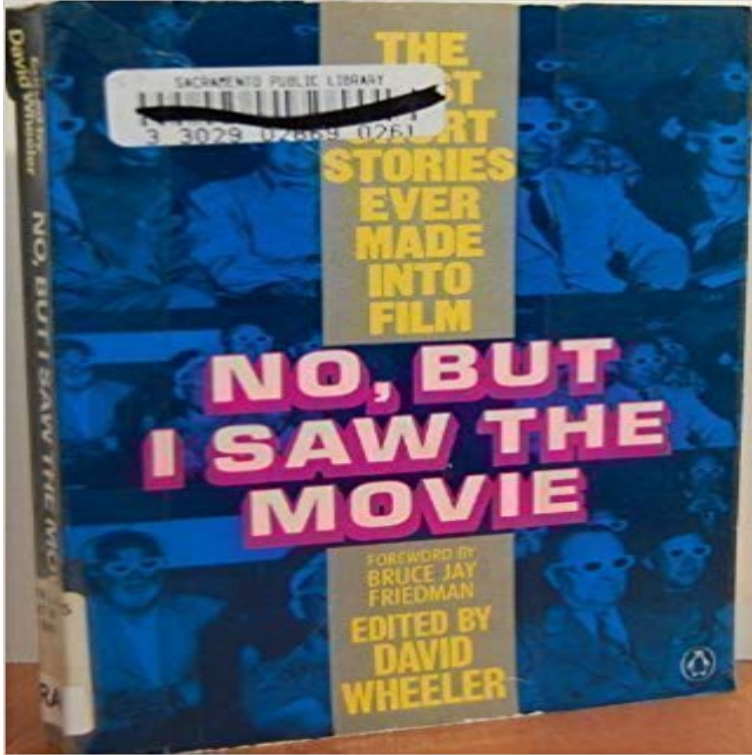


No, But I Saw the Movie: The Best Short Stories Ever Made Into Film
