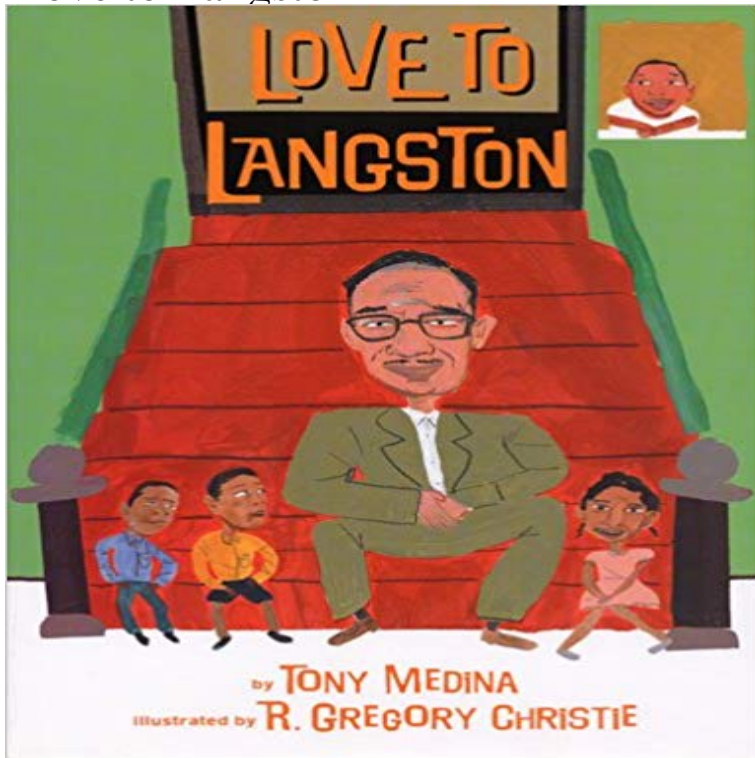


## Love to Langston
