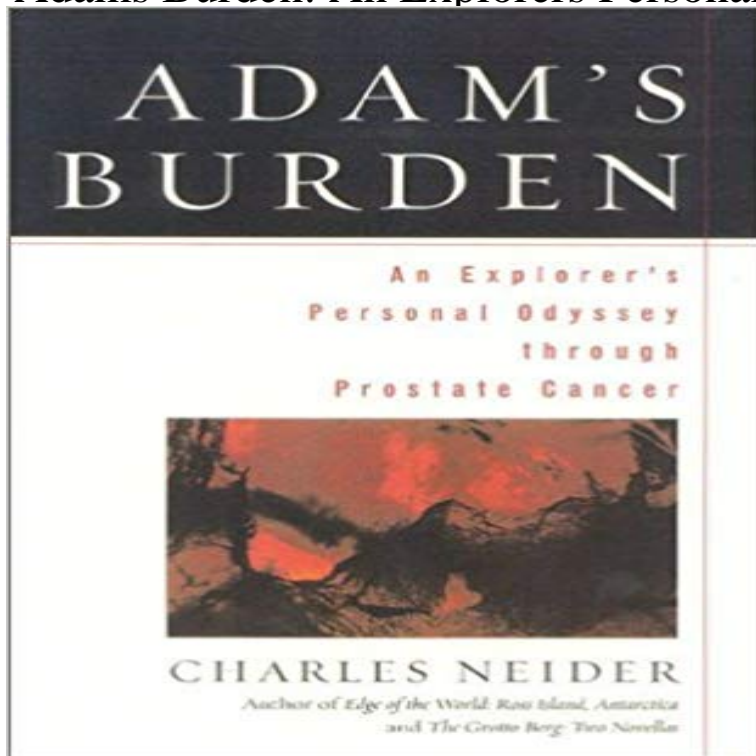


Adams Burden: An Explorers Personal Odyssey through Prostate Cancer
