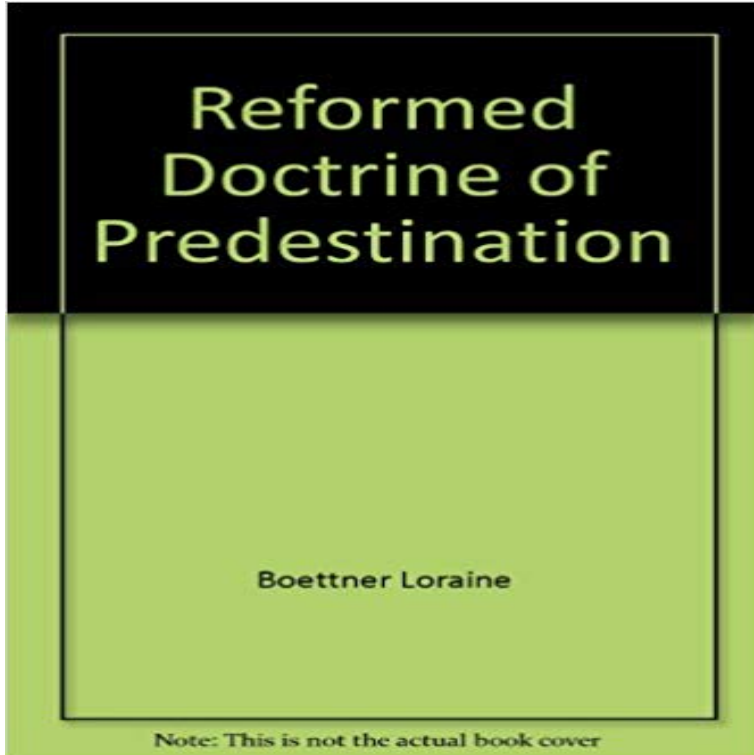


Reformed Doctrine of Predestination
