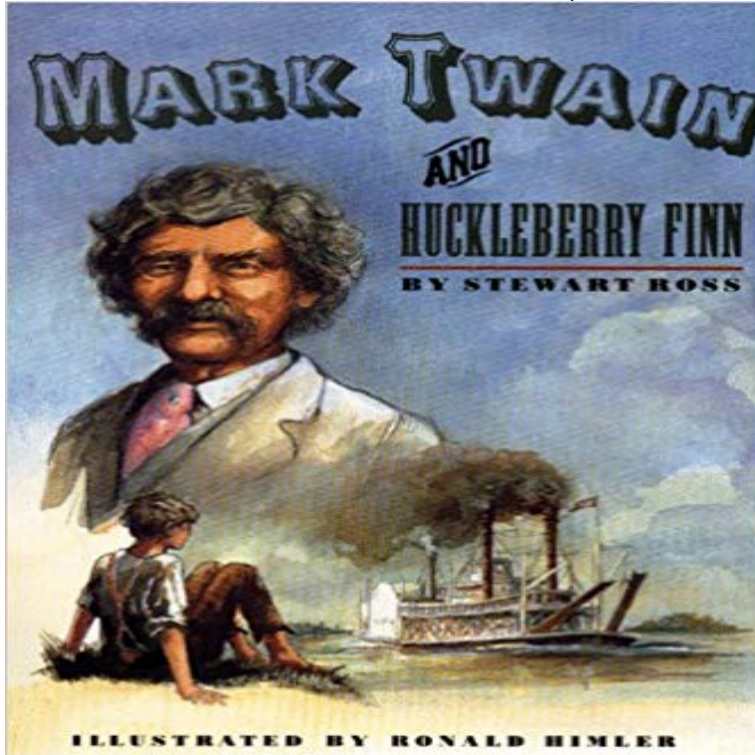


Mark Twain and Huckleberry Finn
