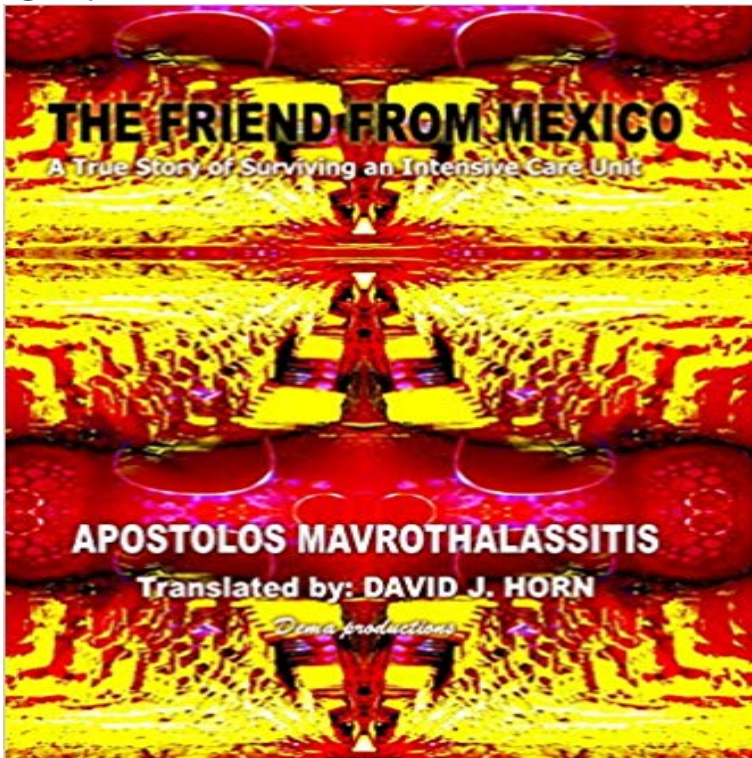


# The Friend From Mexico: A True Story of Surviving an Intensive Care Unit
