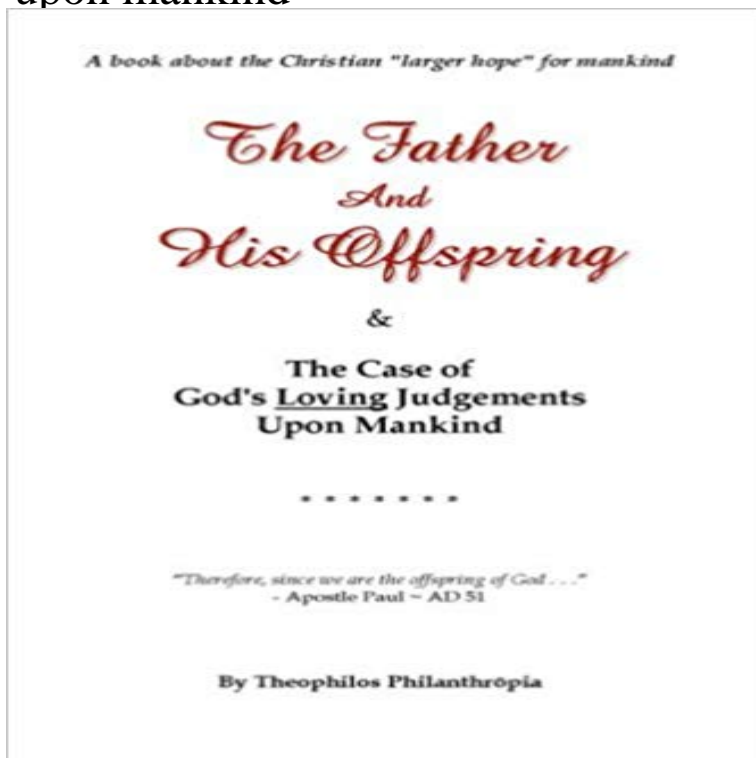


The Father and His Offspring and the case of Gods LOVING judgements upon mankind
