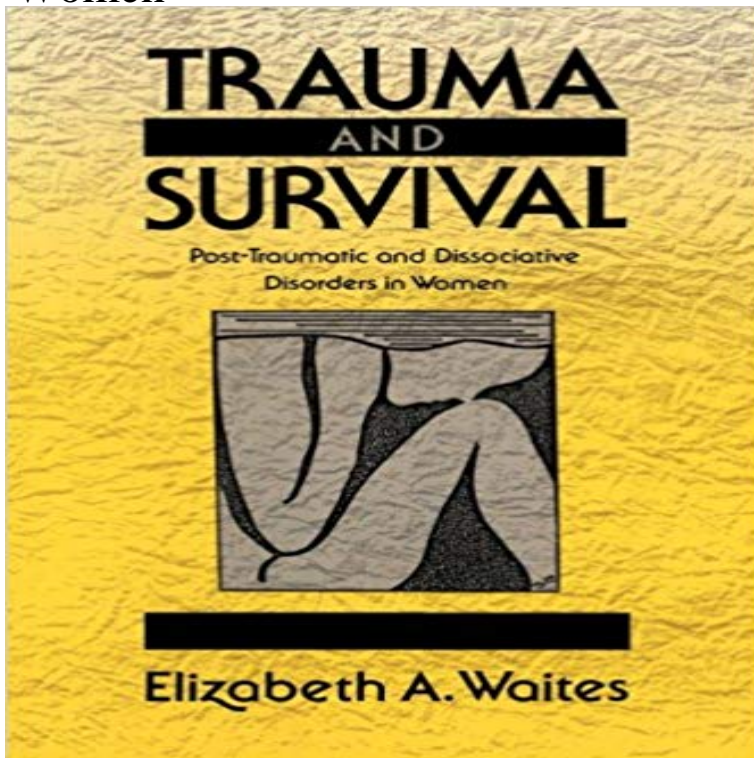


Trauma and Survival: Post-Traumatic and Dissociative Disorders in Women
