The author then examines events in the wake of the Uprising—the military coup in Crimea, the election of President Petro Poroshenko, the Malaysia Airlines tragedy, rising tensions among all of Russia's neighbors, both friend and foe, and more. *Ukraine Crisis* provides an important, accurate record of events that unfolded in Ukraine in 2014.
