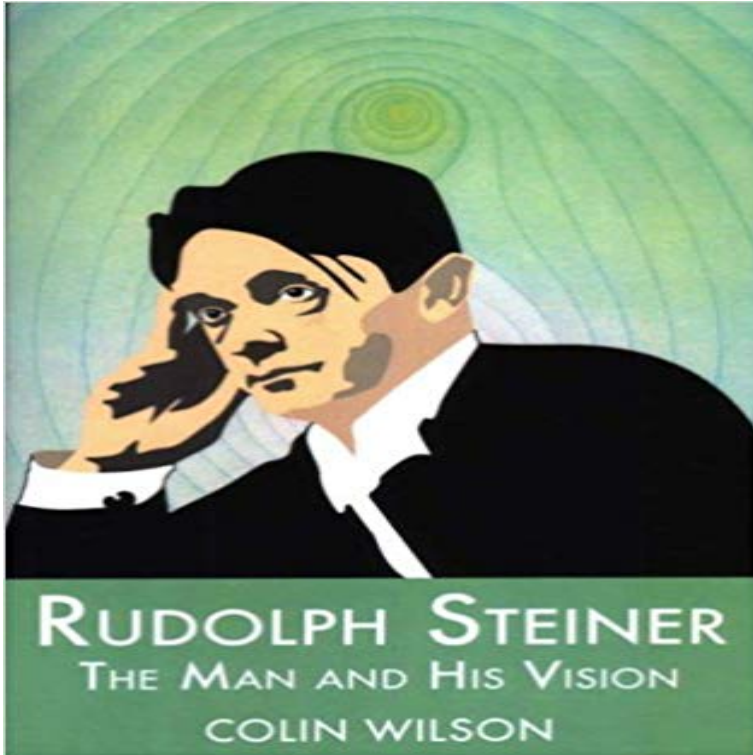


# Rudolf Steiner: The Man and His Vision
