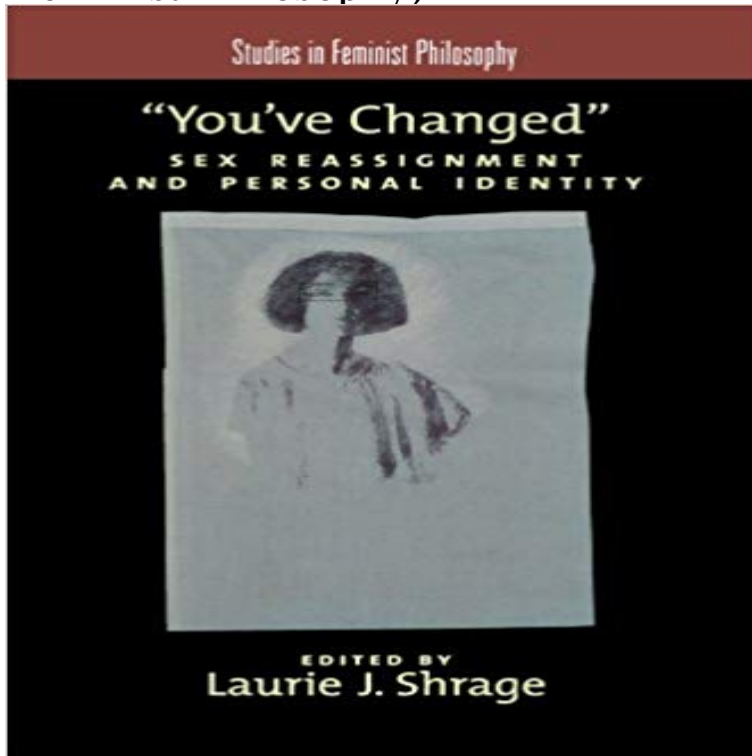


You've Changed: Sex Reassignment and Personal Identity (Studies in Feminist Philosophy)
